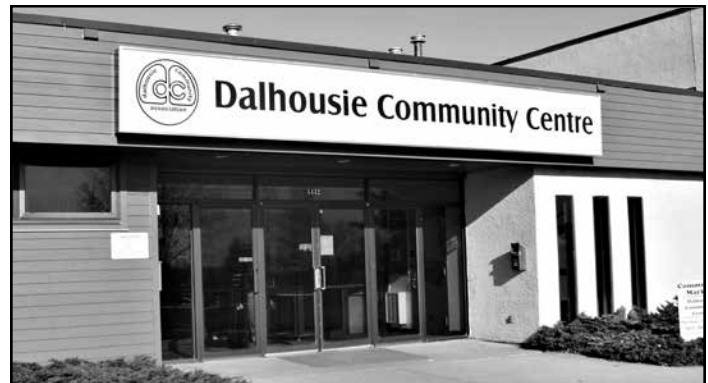
In Our Community

Registering for Kindergarten – Are You (and your child) Ready?

January is registration month for kindergarten programs across the city (even though a new school year seems quite far away!) Other families are comfortable with that decision, but many may still have questions about choosing the right program. Kindergarten is a time for your child to experience social interaction, to develop communication skills, and learn through discovery and exploration. It is definitely a fun and exciting time, and we hope all families have a wonderful experience with Kindergarten. Join us for an Information session on Tuesday January 15 that will help explore some of the questions you may have things you as parent can consider for these decisions.

Our Community Kindergarten program has operated for over 30 years. We provide a proven, well managed program that is publically funded. Our program emphasizes early literacy and language learning, with an introduction to letters, letter sounds, sight words, numbers and math concepts. Our unique focus on an enhanced learning environment means your child will benefit from an exciting variety of unique activities and learning experiences. Birchwood TOD Development Update

The Development Permit (DP) for Phase 1 of the Birchwood high-rise, multi-residential project planned for the corner of Dalhousie Drive & Dalton Drive, east of the Dalhousie LRT Station, was approved by the City's Development Officer at the end of November. Many residents of Dalhousie provided the DCA with feedback through the design process and were reflected in the DCA's comments to the City Planner (also posted on dalhousiecalgary.ca). We were successful in affecting several changes:

- A low-scale enhanced pedestrian friendly façade on Dalhousie Drive that incorporates a 2-storey retail/restaurant feature, a prominent front entry to the building and improved transition to residential to the north;
- An improved interior plaza design that better connects Dalton Drive through the site to the park and LRT with a separated sidewalk to reduce potential vehicle/cyclist/pedestrian conflicts;
- Reduced surface parking on the plaza; enhanced soft landscaping on the plaza side of the Dalhousie Drive building;
- Enhanced plaza connections between buildings and a more prominent entrance to the south building; and
- Removal of the surface generator on the plaza to provide a superior at-grade gathering space for public enjoyment with unobstructed sight lines across the plaza.

The DP approval was advertised in the Calgary Herald on December 6th and posted on the City's website. With that, affected residents were able to appeal the approval to the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board before December 27th. If no appeals were filed, the DP is released if Birchwood met the conditions on the permit – including submitting updated drawings and remitting necessary securities to the City. Going forward, Birchwood will also require a Demolition Permit for the existing structures and a Building Permit prior to construction.

The Planning & Development Committee will continue to work closely with Birchwood and The City to ensure approved conditions are met and that construction is managed to minimize disruption to neighbors and the community until the project is completed. We will continue to update residents on the status of the project on the DCA website as new information is received. Visit dalhousiecalgary.ca for updates.

Happy New Year! The playschool wish you lots of luck and happiness in 2019! We will be having our open house for the 2019-2020 school year on January 15th. The Playschool hosted our first MOVIE NIGHT. The families joined us with cushions and blankets, the children came dressed in their pyjamas and we watched *Incredibles 2* together- with lots of popcorn eaten too! During class time, the children were busy talking about movies and so we turned a part of our classroom into a movie theatre! DRAMATIC or PRETEND PLAY is hugely important for childhood development- it gives the children the opportunity to learn problem solving skills, coordinate plans, cooperate with others and to think flexibly. By acting out familiar themes such as restaurants, doctors' offices and movie theatres, they are making sense of the real life things they observe. The best dramatic play, comes from the interest of the children, but there are many ways these can be fostered at home!

- Read books with your children and get them to recreate the story adding in their own extra ideas and details.
- Provide dolls, stuffed animals, puppets, characters to give them resources to act out their stories. Add an additional activity and make your own together!
- Create boxes with different themed materials in them- doctor supplies, restaurant supplies are a good starting point.
- Give the children time; unstructured and uninterrupted time! Leave a movie theatre set up in the corner of the room for a few days to give them maximum creative opportunities.
