DAY TRIPS IN CANMORE

POLICEMAN'S CREEK

Accessible from downtown Canmore, the Policeman's Creek boardwalk provides an easy and convenient path to take in the scenery. Enjoy the river as you make your way along the boardwalk and across the bridge that leads you through the Spring Creek community, then back to the center of Canmore. At 3.9 kilometers long, this stroll is perfect for families hoping to spend a day in town but who want to enjoy the beauty of the area free from roads

BIKE THE LEGACY TRAIL

Twenty-two kilometers of paved road bridge the gap between Canmore and Banff and this is a popular route for the bicyclists of the area. Following the Trans Canada, the trail features look-out spots arranged for when you need a rest, and even a marked halfway point. The Valley View Day Use Area makes a great stop for a picnic. This trail is noted as a beginner level, so anyone can make their way up and around the Legacy Trail, but if you do get tired, the Roam Transit system can take you and your bike back to Canmore once you get into Banff

CANMORE MUSEUM AND GEOSCIENCE CENTRE

The gorgeous Canmore Museum and Geoscience Centre provides an opportunity to learn about the area around Canmore. From Mine Site Tours to the North Western Mounted Police Barracks to Canmore Engine Bridge, you'll get a taste of history and geology. The permanent exhibits include "From Coal to Community" and the interactive "The Fossils Around Us". This is the perfect chance to take it slow and gain a new layer of appreciation for the geology of Canmore. You won't see it the same way again.

PLAYGROUNDS IN DALHOUSIE

Did you know that the West Dalhousie School, at 6502 58 St NW, has a big, fun playground? There are two gliders, saucer swings, monkey bars, and more!
